DESCRIPTION

Pine Stool crafted by René Martin, known as "René les Ciseaux". A renowned cabinetmaker, he collaborated with Charlotte Perriand on her ski resort projects in Les Arcs and Méribel, in the French Alps.

The stools feature a quadripod base with rounded log legs, supporting a thick circular seat, all crafted in solid pine. This design exemplifies René Martin's refined craftsmanship and the mid-century modern aesthetic, blending simplicity with functionality.
