DESCRIPTION

Blown glass carafe by Claude Morin, a French artist who played a key role in the 1970s revival of glass art. From his studio in Dieulefit, he developed a formal language that is both refined and expressive, exploring the interplay of color and light.

This carafe, mouth-blown in amber-brown glass, features a rounded cylindrical body, a straight slightly flared neck, and a high handle . The bubbles and small irregularities within the glass emphasize the artisanal nature of the work.

Signed underneath the base: Dieulefit.
