DESCRIPTION

Pair of black lacquered metal wall lights designed by Jacques Biny and produced by Lita in the 1950s. Each sconce is mounted on a pivoting arm and features a frosted glass diffuser in a lens-like shape, providing soft, directional light.

A discreet yet significant figure of postwar French lighting, Jacques Biny is known for his functional approach and refined, understated designs developed in collaboration with prominent decorators and manufacturers.
