DESCRIPTION

Sculptural floral lamp designed by Georg Jensen and produced by Royal Copenhagen in Denmark in the mid 20th century.

The composition takes the form of a stylized bouquet, made of slender dark metal stems topped with thick molded glass diffusers shaped like flower buds. The glass features subtly irregular contours and nuanced transparency, creating a soft and lively light. The cylindrical metal base incorporates cut and patinated leaf elements, reinforcing the botanical and sculptural character of the piece.

Positioned between lighting object and decorative sculpture, this lamp reflects the dialogue between Georg Jensen's organic design language and Royal Copenhagen's craftsmanship, offering a modernist interpretation of natural forms characteristic of Danish design in the 1950s-1960s.
