DESCRIPTION

Kampur Dining Table, designed by Michele De Lucchi, circa 1980.

Sculptural and refined, the Kampur dining table is distinguished by its harmonious interplay of form and material. The substantial circular base supports an ovoid column, which elevates a thick, round Carrara marble tabletop, delicately inlaid with striking Nero Marquina marble. The contrast between the luminous white of Carrara and the deep, dark
