## DESCRIPTION

Fiandra modular sofa designed by Vico Magistretti for Cassina. Developed in the late 1970s, this iconic seating system is composed of independent modules that can be freely assembled to create a generous and inviting sofa, with low, comfortable lines characteristic of Italian design from the late 1970s and early 1980s.

Upholstered entirely in black leather, the sofa features soft cushions and a rectilinear yet enveloping form, striking a balance between formal clarity and everyday comfort. Each large module measures 95 cm in width. In the corner

configuration shown, the overall footprint is approximately 2.80 m by 2.80 m.

Conceived as an adaptable system, Fiandra offers great compositional freedom and is equally suited to contemporary living spaces and more classic interiors.
