DESCRIPTION

Set of six dark-stained solid oak chairs designed by Henry Jacques Le Même, circa 1940.

They stand out with their tapered legs supporting a square seat with softened corners. The backrest, made of vertical uprights joined by horizontal slats, conveys a strong and precise geometry. With their robust construction and architectural presence, these chairs embody the spirit of mountain furniture and the modernist approach that Le Même developed in his alpine projects.
