DESCRIPTION

Pair of chairs by Christian Durupt, produced as part of the interior furnishings developed for the Méribel ski resort under the direction of Charlotte Perriand in the 1960s. An emblematic expression of alpine modernist design, combining function with a strong sculptural presence.

The silhouette is bold and immediately striking. Strong lines, a thick seat and a compact back create a powerful visual balance. The tapered legs bring both lightness and elegance, giving the chairs a confident architectural allure.
