DESCRIPTION

Set of six dark-stained solid oak chairs designed by Henry Jacques Le Môme circa 1940.

Each piece rests on tapered legs supporting a square seat with rounded edges. The backrest, composed of two sections, is joined by horizontal slats that emphasize the simple, rigorous geometry of the design. With their sturdy yet refined construction, these chairs reflect both the mountain aesthetic and the modernist approach developed by Jacques Le Môme in his alpine projects.
