DESCRIPTION

Pair of solid pine benches produced in the 1970s for the Les Arcs 1800 ski resort.

Their straightforward and sturdy construction reflects furniture designed for collective use and alpine interiors. The restrained design emphasizes function, stability and material presence. This type of bench belongs to the furnishing selections made at Les Arcs under the coordination of Charlotte Perriand.

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
