An icon of Italian design, the SCIANGAI coat rack is inspired by the famous pick-up sticks game, mimicking its star-like unfolded shape. Crafted in solid ash with a white lacquer finish, this elegant and functional coat rack combines simplicity with ingenuity. Its articulated arms open to form a stable yet lightweight structure, ideal for holding clothes, bags, or hats, while folding easily to save space.

A true sculptural object, SCIANGAI transcends its utilitarian purpose to become a centerpiece of interior design. Its timeless design and refined aesthetic showcase the creative brilliance of its designers and the exceptional craftsmanship of Zanotta.
