DESCRIPTION

Model T07 bedside table in solid elm designed by Pierre Chapo in the mid 1960s and produced by Atelier Chapo in France.

The piece stands on four solid legs joined by a characteristic stretcher system typical of Chapo's approach to solid wood construction. The rectangular top supports a compact upper volume with a single front drawer assembled with visible straight dovetails. The craftsmanship highlights the density and deep grain of the elm, enhanced by a natural

patina acquired over time.
