DESCRIPTION

The "M" table, a part of the Lang series by designer Philippe Starck, boasts a rectangular frosted glass top poised atop four triangular legs crafted from cast aluminum. The sloping legs, with their elegantly tapered bodies, serve as a defining characteristic of Starck's design aesthetic, giving the table a blend of sophistication and refinement.

Originally conceived by Philippe Starck in 1984 and manufactured by the renowned Italian company Driade as part of the Aleph collection, the "M" dining table stands as an iconic symbol of the series and bears the signature "Starck"

atop its legs.
