DESCRIPTION

The elegance of mid-century modern Japanese design with the Mitzukaeshi coffee table, crafted by Isamu Kenmochi for Tendo Mokko in the 1960s. This piece beautifully merges traditional craftsmanship with modern innovations, exemplifying the manufacturer's excellence in bentwood furniture.

The Mitzukaeshi table is distinguished by its elegantly sculpted curved legs and refined edge, creating a seamless, harmonious flow. The Brasilian rosewood veneer showcases a rich grain and intricate patterns, adding warmth and

character. This rare piece effortlessly complements a variety of interior styles, from Scandinavian minimalism to contemporary and bohemian aesthetics.

The Tendo Mokko logo is present under the tabletop.
